The Cass County Sheriff's Office and Leech Lake Tribal Police - Emergency Management Divisions will be hosting 2 in person Skywarn Storm Spotter trainings in April. Minnesota's Severe Weather Awareness Week is **April 17-21, 2023**. An informed community makes for a more resilient community and the Skywarn program helps build a cooperative relationship between the National Weather Service and the community to assist in the receipt and effective distribution of weather information. These classes are FREE, are two hours long and cover the following topics:

- Basics of thunderstorm development
- Fundamentals of storm structure
- Identifying potential severe weather features
- Information to report
- How to report information
- Basic severe weather safety
